## REVERSABLE FELTED PULLOVER TOP WITH PINE-NEEDLE DETAIL

### Material list

- Name tag
- Coffee mug
- Plastic to cover your work table

**Wool:** For the main part of the pullover: Merino top (18 micron) : 600g~

The pullover is reversible and you can use 2 different colours.

**Pine Needles part:** 75~100g of 16~18micron merino top and / or fine merino (under 18 micron) mixed with silk top (~50%). Please make sure the micron of merino wool with silk mixed top.

**Bubble wrap:** One piece of 150cm width x 450cm length

One piece 40 x 50cm for sample making.

(If you need to tape them together, please tape them STRAIGHT and FLAT. If you need help or space to tape them, please come to the venue early)

**Sheet of paper** to draw the pattern: 150 x 120cm~. Any kind of paper, taping together the small pieces is fine.

**Plastic for the resist:** Two of plastic table cover (54"x108", 1.37m x 2.74m) from \$shop. Simple LIGHT colour, no design or pattern.

### Rolling pole:

- 2 - 2~3cm (1~1.5") diameter x over 150cm (5 feet)
- 2 - 7~10cm (2.7~4") diameter x over 150cm (5 feet). Pool noodle, PVC, wood.
- 1 - 2~3cm diameter x 40cm~ for sample making
  - "Diameter" here is the size of the outside but the hollow.
- 4 Small plastic bags (for preparing the wool and for your hand for rubbing)
- Plastic bottle or something to sprinkle the soapy water.
- Masking tape
- Cellophane tape
- Scissors to cut the plastic bags.
- Small good pair of scissors to work with wet wool
- Knitting needle or something similar form for pushing wet wool
- Soap (liquid and bar)
- Ties to tie the rolled bubble sheet to roll (something stretch would be good. I use the cut-out of old T-shirt ) (6)
- Towels Water spray bottle to kill the static electricity.
- Small bowl to dip the wool (Tupperware, soup bowl...etc.)
- Permanent marker (sharpie, any colour)
- Ruler : 100cm ( yard stick)
- Tape measure
- Drawing pencil and rubber
- triangular set square
- Plastic bag to take the wet piece home!
- Lots of happy good energy!

### Optional

- Nonslip mat" for cupboard for rolling. 100~120cm square
- Fabric, yarns for design
