Student requirement list

- Name tag
- Coffee mug
- Plastic to cover your 2 worktables
- 4 metres (needlefelted merino wool batts) available from Fibre fusion askus@fibrefusion.com.au or silksational sales@silksational.com.au . They can be the same colour or different colours to make up the 4 metres.
- An assortment of pieces of silk fabric to make up about 4 metres. (This will be used as the surface design). The silk needs to be either a 3.5momme weight tissue silk available from Silksational sales@silksational.com.au or phone 0297566554. This can be purchased in black, white, coloured or patterned. The other type of silk which works well is chiffon which is available from fabric shops. Silk or cotton gauze works well also. Silk mesh available from treetop harmonies, incredibly gorgeous info@treetopscolours.com.au
- 3.5 metres bubblewrap plastic. 1.5 wide
- 4 old towels
- 1 packet of thin, clear painters plastic , available from hardware stores
- 1 pool noodle 1.5 long
- 1 x 2 litre milk bottle with 10 holes in the lid.
- Table raisers for 2 tables (can be Blocks or cans of food or plastic potplants to raise tables for felting)
- 1 wooden dowel or pvc pipe , width of broom handle, 1.5metres long
- Sharp scissors, pins, needle and thread to match needlefelted wool batts
- Paper to draft pattern for jacket.
- Tape measure
- Buttons for jacket
- Knitting yarn bits for decoration, optional
- Sewing machine, extension cord& power board
- Overlocker (optional but we will need at least 6 in the class, so if you have one bring it)
- Dress making mannequin, optional
- 2 metres bias binding to match needlefelt
