- Water bottle

MATERIAL LIST

If you live in Victoria, you're welcome to bring some foliage in – Various Eucalyptus, fern, Cotinus, Silky Oak, Grevillea, bark etc...

- Pressed foliage and flowers (for cyanotype)
- 6 or more large sheets of watercolour paper (I prefer 100% rag watercolour paper, hot pressed around 300gsm) Saunders Waterford Hot Press is my favourite.
- 2 full sheets of Japanese paper "Awagami Kitakata"
- Select any other watercolour or printmaking paper you may have.
- An old white sheet for ripping into lengths.
- 2-4 lengths of iron pipe 20cm length
- Large Bull dog clips x 8
- 2 sheets of glass with a backing board – backing board can be plywood or thick cardboard. IKEA sell glass shelving - KALLAX Glass Shelf, Op shops are another good source for frames
- Foam and bristle brushes
- Small Spray bottles x 2
- An opaque jar with lid – I picked up a coffee keep cup from the op shop that's works well.
- Any size gel plate
- Roller/brayer
- If you have any soft chalk pastels please bring along
- Sponge applicator (like a makeup sponge)
- Acrylic paint include white & black
- Glue- Matt medium, PVA, etc

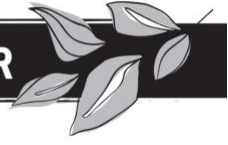
