Tutor: Basil Hall

- Coffee mug, name tag and plastic to cover your work-table
- Wear old clothes
- Rags for clean up
- Disposable gloves (a packet of the close fitting ones; not the big formless floppy ones or washing up gloves)
- Pencil and some small brushes, suitable for gluing
- Ideas in the form of drawings, photos, iPads or a willingness to wander the garden and draw in it!
- Small Exacto or Olfa cutting knife (the ones with a pencil handle and a replaceable fine point)
- Small squirty bottle of PVA glue
- Other printmaking tools that they think might make interesting marks
- Any interesting textural stuff such as a variety of papers, tissue, corrugated card, thin card, old textured wallpapers, cereal box card, fine bandage, glad wrap, thin wet and dry sandpaper, fine fabric and even some more organic things like oats, lichen, salt and other fine plant material.

Materials fee: \$70 to be paid on the first day of the workshop in cash to the tutor
