Materials list

- Plastic to cover your table, Coffee mug and name tag

These are essential colours:

WATERCOLOURS

Sepia
Cadmium Yellow
Hooker's or Cobalt Green
Olive Green
Ultramarine blue
Burnt Sienna
Raw Umber
Paynes Gray
Neutral Tint

But please, do bring your other colours also.

Make sure your watercolours are of good quality ie Schmincke Horadam etc or any quality brand on special 😊

GOUACHE

1 x Large tube Permanent White
1 x smaller tube Black gouache ie Ivory black

I prefer Permanent White gouache in Winsor Newton. Art Spectrum gouache is excellent also. Please feel free to bring any other colours you have.

BRUSHES

You will need 2 x good quality 'round' brushes for finer work.
No's size 'O' and '1' in sable or similar quality.

There are some excellent quality synthetic mixes so best to speak with your art supplier also about this.

In Synthetic or imitation sable, you will need a flat wash brush and brushes sizes 2 and 4

The above sizes are important but please feel free to bring any brushes you have.

WATERCOLOUR PAPER

You will need 2-3 sheets 640 GSM **HOT PRESS** rag paper in size 56 cms x 76 cms. Either Lana, Fabriano etc. They must be quality papers and they **MUST** be hot press smooth sheets.

Please bring a watercolour pad also for trial work.
