## STEPPING INTO DRAWING AND PAINTING

Tutor: Ryan Brealey

- Sketchbook A4 or A3, Landscape bound is useful but not essential
- Graphite Pencils in these grades: 8B, 6B, 4B, 2B, HB, 2H
- Kneadable eraser
- Solid Graphite pencil either a 6B or 8B
- Set of different sized paper stumps for blending
- Spray Atomiser with a screw adjustable nozzle
- 4 large soy sauce dishes
- White plain tile approx 20x30cms
- Cloth rags
- Box of tissues
- Jars of different sizes with lids for Water, mediums and solvents, approx 6-8
- Masking tape, preferably the blue painters tape from hardware stores
- Scotch invisible tape (green packet)
- A board, either Masonite or MDF approx 45x65cm for taping paper to
- Cutting knives, ruler, sharpeners, scissors erasers etc
- Offcut of cardboard, boxboard or mount board for picture framing approx A3 in size
- Any materials that participants may already have, eg paints and brushes etc
- Any Hog Hair brushes for oil painting, mix of sizes and shapes
- Any synthetic Brushes , Mix of sizes and shapes
- Any painting knives of different sizes and shapes

**Materials fee:- \$100 to be paid to the tutor in cash on the first day of the workshop. This will cover a range of paints, papers and boards to be used in the workshop.**
