- Plastic to cover your work table

A basic range of colours as suggested below “optional colours” are not essential

- **Acrylic paint**
- Any brand will be suitable;
- Titanium white
- Antique white
- Carbon Black
- Cadmium yellow light
- Naphthol red light or
- cadmium red light
- Alizarin crimson
- Sap green
- Cobalt blue
- Cerulean blue
- Ultramarine blue
- Burnt sienna or
- ‘Transparent’ red oxide
- Yellow ochre/oxide
- Burnt umber
- Paynes grey

( **OPTIONAL COLOURS** ) \*phthalo turquoise, \*cobalt turquoise light, \*orange, , \*brilliant violet, \* vermillion, brilliant magenta Dioxazine purple, red black

### **MEDIUMS**

- Liquitex or matesse gloss medium/varnish

### **CANVAS**

- approx 40x50cms 60x40cms 76x76cm or smaller stretched canvases will be suitable. Larger if you wish!
- old towel or rags
- 1 cheap plastic table cloth/drop sheets or old towel
- Large Flat plastic tray or baking tray to be used as a wet palette!!!
- 4 bulldog clips .
