LIGHT & LIFE – FIGURE DRAWING IN CHARCOAL AND PASTEL

PLEASE BRING

- Name tag
- Coffee mug
- Plastic to cover your table
- Water bottle – *its summer and we need to keep up our fluids!*

MATERIAL LIST

- 3-4 Willow charcoal sticks, thick are best.
- 1 Charcoal pencil.
- 1-2 paper stumps
- 1 Kneadable eraser,
- 1 pencil or hard eraser.
- 2 Bulldog clips.
- 4 -5 Coloured pastels, mix of earth and cool colours. (burnt sienna, burnt umber, raw umber, yellow ochre and ultramarine or Payne's grey are good)
- Bulky news paper (rough textured, not the shiny butchers' paper) Allow about 8 sheets per day).
- Drawing easel. A simple A frame is best, but a painting easel will do.
- Drawing board, about 70 cm x 50cm

NB: Linda will bring bulky news paper and sell it for 20c a sheet if people don't bring their own.
