SEEDARTLAB : SEED DIVERSITY TO ABSTRACTION

TUTOR: SOPHIE MUNNS

PLEASE BRING

- Name tag
- Coffee mug
- Water bottle – *its summer and we need to keep up our fluids!*

MATERIAL LIST (Perhaps sharing is possible if you don't have everything on this list)

- Seed collection. Coming from QLD the artist will bring a selection of species but collectively a showcase of regional diversity you contribute to is ideal.
- Several black pens (artline, PITT etc) & new Journal (A4 - A3)
- An older Journal, Images/photographs for reference if you wish.
- Butcher paper to cover your workspace
- Wear comfortable clothing and sturdy, non-slip footwear. We may be working outside on several different surfaces. Bring a hat/sunscreen
- Smartphone Camera for photography exercises and documentation.
- Bring along a small mixed media pack of your favourites - for drawing/painting/mixed media exploration - choose from what you own - ink, gouache, watercolours, oil pastels, acrylic paint, colour pencils. Small selection (Material fee DOES include a variety of media, some inks, a rigger brush each ... check that list).
- various sized brushes needed - pack a few of your mixed favourites + sizes
- Include an old worn dry bristly brush or two .. we will be scumbling!
- Rigger brush (size 1 or 2) for white ink if you own one (1 included in fee)
- **A MUST:** Tiny lidded plastic jars for ink work - eg 6 small jars (try kmart etc)
- Repurposed polystyrene meat trays (or such) to mix paints on
- Small cutting mat
- Basic Stanley knife or similar
- Scissors
- small sticky or masking tape
- small 250gm PVA glue
- Ruler OR small tape measure
- Mark making tools from plant material, all size twigs. Collect onsite + home
- Small water containers - repurpose smallish food plastic tubs with lids.
- Small envelope of mixed/unused papers/surfaces for collage/artist books
- Mixed Media paper - A3 pad eg 25 pages
- Cartridge Paper 200 gsm - A2 or A3 Cartridge Paper is cheap but handy for prolific drawers!

- Linen/Calico? (note amount supplied in the fee)
- Butchers or Cartridge paper for wrapping artwork at the end.
- Paper towel roll
- if you have any inks/watercolours/acrylics bring some fav colours.
- string, open weave fabrics, muslin, can be added to the artist book envelope. Also needle + some threads if you like stitching on artwork
- Old Maps if interested - your local area/region. Used condition good.

Payable to the tutor on the first day of the workshop in cash - Material fee \$65.

Materials included in the material fee:

- Art Spectrum ink in White, Black, Indigo, Burnt Sienna, Magenta, Orange for decanting into your tiny lidded plastic pots.
- Acrylic paints - a range of colours for mixing your unique exploration of nature palettes
- Wide-ranging Papers will be supplied in long panels for concertina books and artist books - heavy cartridge paper, watercolour paper, cottonrag paper, tissue paper, tracing paper, rice paper, Kraft paper.
- Brushes - one rigger brush per person + use of a range of brushes. BYO to avoid disappointment if you are very particular.
- Fabric - Linen and Calico 1 metre x 50 cm long panel of each for painting on
- Fabric fixative/gesso - enough for fabric supplied in fee. BYO extra if bringing extra fabric
- Basic needles and thread
- Plus extra mixed media and surfaces for experimentation.

As for Seed Material it is hoped a connection can be made with those in the local Seed Conservation Science community and similar organisations where possible ... in order to access regionally significant species we could explore in the workshop.
