MATERIALS LIST

- **Paints:** Artists quality tubes: Ultramarine Blue, Cobalt Blue, Cerulean Blue, Lemon Yellow, Quinacridone Gold, Yellow Ochre, Alizarin Crimson, Pyrrol Red, Burnt Sienna, Sepia, Cobalt Turquoise, White Gouache
- **Paper:** Arches or Saunders 300gsm Rough – 2 paintings each day ¼ sheet size (38cm x 28cm) or ½ sheet if you would like to work larger (57cm x 38cm)
- A5 Spiral bound watercolour sketch book
- Palette with plenty of mixing areas and lid/wells to hold fresh paint
- **Brushes:** Oval Wash No 12, 8 & 6 Rigger: size 2 Round: size 6 (with good point)
Hake: size 4cm, Wooden handle pastry brush & tooth brush
- Coreflute Board: 50cm x 45cm (Bunnings) or lightweight drawing board.
- Pencil: 2B Pencil, sharpener, soft eraser
- Water jar, tissues, old towel to cover table, masking tape (25mm),
- Small water spray bottle, Easel (optional)
- Reference material will be provided
