Please bring all your materials to set-up your work space in the classroom and meet your tutor after registration. **NB.** Dinner is available at 6pm and ALL are welcome. For non-residential students please **RSVP for catering** purposes you can pay on the night.

CLASS TIMES AND ARRANGEMENTS: Classes commence at 9.00am sharp until 4.00pm. Please ensure that you are at your classroom with ample time to be set up and ready for your class to commence at 9.00am.

SPECIAL DIETS: Have you told us of your special dietary requirements? (You should have done this when you originally booked in.) It is essential that we know this information now. Morning tea and lunch are provided for all students. Our catering is very simple: fruit and biscuits etc for morning tea and cold meat and salad wraps, rolls, and salads etc for lunch. We keep it to these simple arrangements as there are a lot of people to cater for. Tea, sugar, milk and plunger coffee is provided in your class room. If you require more than regular tea, plunger coffee or special milk we ask you to please bring your own. We will not be providing instant coffee.

LIGHTING: If your class involves fine close-up work it's recommended that you bring a desk lamp, extension cord and power board.

ART SUPPLIES: Senior Art will be on-site from midday Monday 20 January until midday Tuesday 21 January. If you are requiring an specific materials for your workshop they will have most materials available.

ACCOMMODATION: If you have booked on campus accommodation (residential) and have opted for BYO linen please note you need to bring single sheets, doona, pillow + towel. If you would like to have linen supplied this is an additional cost of \$175 for the week. Please advise ASAP so we can arrange linen.

The residential accommodation has shared bathrooms and kitchenette.

TRAVEL: from Melbourne to Horsham / Return

If you are commuting with public transport from **Melbourne** you will need to leave Melbourne (Southern Cross Station) by train at 8.16am Sunday 19 January to arrive in Horsham at 12.46pm. The train will stop at Ararat and you will be required to board the coach from Ararat to Horsham. This will allow you plenty of time to have lunch. Returning to Melbourne Saturday 25 January departing by coach either 7.35am to arrive in Melbourne at 12.40pm OR departing 2.00pm from Horsham and arriving in Melbourne at 6.40pm

TRAVEL: from Adelaide to Horsham / Return

If you are commuting with public transport from **Adelaide** you will need to leave Adelaide (VLine coach) at 7.20am Sunday 19 January to arrive in Horsham at 1.25pm. 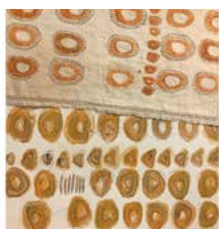

CODE RED (CATASTROPHIC) FIRE PLAN

- We have a duty of care to advise participants when a Code Red is issued or other emergency declared.
- All participants will be advised as soon as a public announcement is made, and on the day the coordinator will attend all class rooms to notify participants.
- Participants will be advised they should enact their own personal emergency plans.
- Information provided at these briefings will be that if students and tutors do not feel safe and are uncomfortable staying in Longerengong then they leave for the day (go to Horsham or return to their home). The designated "Neighbourhood Safe Place" is beside the Swimming pool. This is a place of last resort only and will be used to assemble participants if required. A list of those gathered will be taken.
- Summer Brushes programs will only be CANCELED if there is an emergency that directly threatens Longerengong or other emergency posing an immediate threat to the Wimmera area.
- Any new arrangements will be advised throughout the day to participants, and each venue will be kept in contact through the class/venue contact person, tutors and coordinator.
- In the case of an emergency, Code Red Day or a fire at Longerengong regular contact will be made with local police and other emergency personnel (CFA/Parks Vic) to monitor the fire situation.
- Students and tutors will be briefed at the beginning of classes of any emergency or Code Red Fire Plan.
- Participants will be briefed at the beginning of each class re the location of the Neighbourhood Safe Place.
- In the event of a Code Red day being declared or other emergency the Event Coordinator will be notified of the Code Red Plan.
- In the event of the need to evacuate Longerengong an alternative day activity program will be organized in Horsham including visits to the Horsham Regional Art Gallery and Town Hall.
